

The Teaching Academy of Public Universities will hold its annual conference in Veröld – House of Vigdís, on **Friday, 21 November 2025, from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM**. The conference is intended for everyone concerned with university-level teaching, including instructors, students, and administrators.

This year's conference hosts are members of the Teaching Academy from the School of Health Sciences at the University of Iceland.

Participation is free of charge and open to all, but registration is required to estimate attendance. <u>You can register here</u>. Coffee and tea will be served during the conference, and light refreshments will be provided afterwards.

The focus of the conference is:

Artificial intelligence in learning and teaching in higher education.

Please note, however, that all abstracts related to university teaching are welcome.

Those interested in giving a presentation should send a 250–300-word abstract to kennsluakademia@hi.is, including the title, authors, and presenter of the talk. Presentations can cover both research on one's own teaching and/or a description of innovations, adaptations, or challenges in teaching and how the teacher approached the task. The conference will be held mostly in Icelandic. If an abstract is submitted in English, it is nonetheless expected that the presentation will be delivered in English.

The deadline for submitting abstracts is 10th of October. Accepted abstracts will be published on the Teaching Academy's website after the conference. Further information can be found on the Academy's website.
